CAMPER'S KIT LIST – What to bring!

- sleeping bag, extra blankets, a pillow, bed sheet, flashlight
- camp clothes for all kinds of weather: long pants, shorts, t-shirt, sweatshirts, lots of socks and underwear, jacket, raincoat, pajamas, bathing suit, rain boots, camp shoes with a backstrap (no flip flops, flats, crocs without strap)
- soap, toothpaste, tooth brush, comb and/or brush, sanitary protection, sunscreen, insect repellent (not the spray kind), towels, and face cloth
- water bottle, small backpack with your name on it
- plastic bag – may be used for wet bathing suit and towel on the last day of camp
- it is recommended that camper's belongings be packed in a large plastic tub, rather than suitcases

NOTE: All articles must be marked with the camper's name.

***Please do not send or bring food, candy, gum, cell phones, digital cameras, radios, knives, or cigarettes. If a camper has any of these items, the director will keep them in the office until pick-up.**

ALSO NOTE: Camp Kee-Mo-Kee reserves the right to send any camper home during camp if deemed necessary.

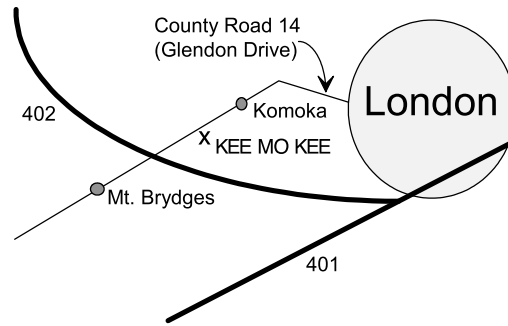

Camp Arrival and Departure Times

Most camps begin **Sunday afternoon at 4:00 pm** (exceptions noted below). You may check-in between 4:00 pm and 5:00 pm. In order to give staff a chance to prepare, the laneway into the camp will be blocked until 4:00 pm. Please try to arrive after 4:00 to reduce traffic congestion. If you do arrive early, please be patient, wait in your car, and we will be ready to start check-in at 4:00. Pick-up time is **Friday from 4:00 – 5:00 pm**.

Exceptions:

3-night camps will run **Tuesday at 4:00 pm** until **Friday at 4:00 pm. (July 3rd - 6th and Aug 7th - 10th)**
Family Camp begins **Sunday at 4:00 pm** until **Wednesday at 1:00 pm. (Aug 26th - Aug 29th)**

When you arrive at camp...

- * Please follow the directions of the parking attendants. Parking space is limited, so we need your cooperation. Please remain in your cars until you have been directed to a parking spot.
- * You will check in with the registrar, and then see the Health Care Provider for a brief interview and a check for head lice. Following this you may meet staff and look around the facilities if you wish.
- * Cabin assignments are made before campers arrive. Every effort will be made to accommodate your cabin requests, however large groups of friends work against our efforts to foster new friendships and allow everyone to feel welcome. Only one cabin mate request is guaranteed. Thank you for your understanding.
- * T-shirts are made available to purchase on registration day for \$15.00, if you have not already qualified for a free t-shirt by registering before April 15th!
- * Picture CDs will also be made and are available for purchase for \$2.00. You must pay for your CD during registration day, in order to give the staff a chance to make the appropriate number of CDs for pick-up.
- * We are also happy to provide a mail box at drop-off where you can leave mail for your campers to receive throughout the week. We ask, however, that you avoid sending food to the camp, in case of allergies.
